

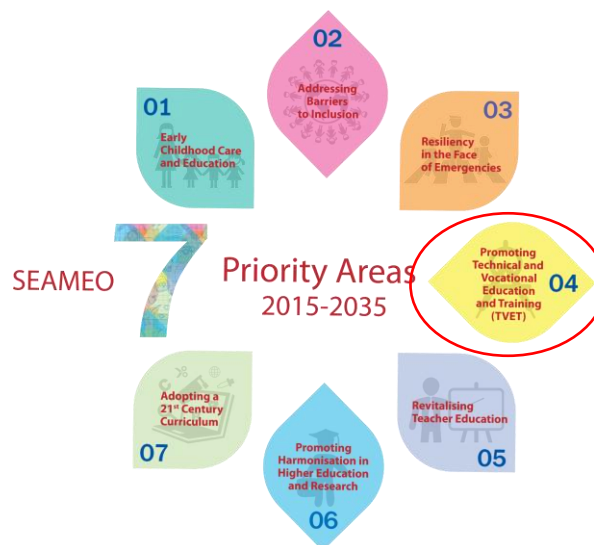

## Brief SEA-TVET Plan on Harmonisation and Internationalisation

2015 - 2016

- Strengthening cooperation among countries and developing regional policy directions and priority areas
- Developing partnership and commitment among TVET institutions in the region
- Developing SEA-TVET Consortium in SEA region

2016-2018

- Harmonising curriculum and occupational mapping
- Improving leaders, administrators, teachers, students
- Improving innovation in TVET
- Improve involvement of industries
- **Expand SEA-TVET Consortium and partnership to other regions through capacity development and internationalisation**

- **2** Leadership Trainings for TVET Leaders in Solo 2015 and BKK 2016
- Development of SEA-TVET Consortium with **400** members
- SEAMEO-Polytechnic Network with **62** members
- SEA-TVET Scholarships with **50** scholarship offered to TVET students (Just started)
- SEA- Future Teachers with **50-100** Pre-Service Teacher Exchange in 2016

  - For all levels from ministries/countries → institutions → leaders → teachers → students

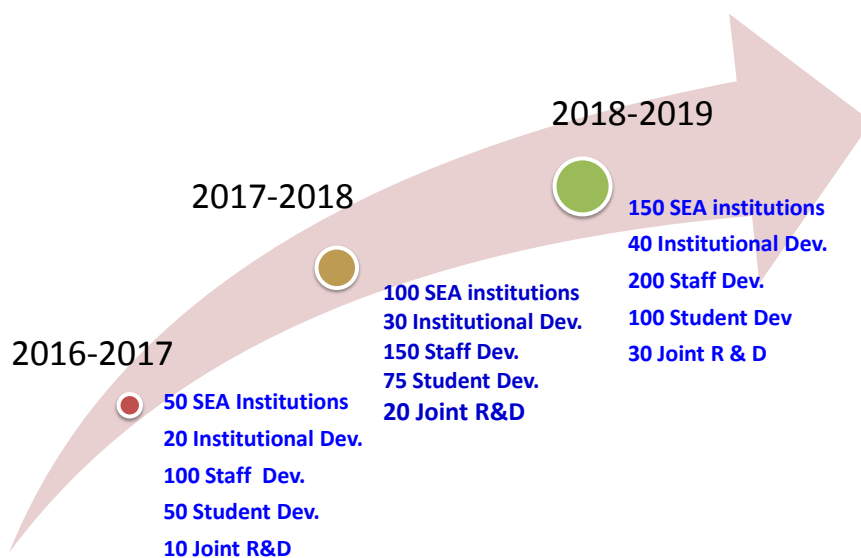
## Proposed Collaboration with KOSEN/Japan

## Proposed 3 Year Road Map: SEA TVET– KOSEN Consortium



## Proposed Activities

### 1) 1<sup>st</sup> SEA-TVET KOSEN Meeting on 14-15 July 2016 (TODAY)

- 25 institutions from 7 countries
- Preparing partnership plan for improving institutions, staff , student and R&D

### 2) Prepare “Teacher Training Centre Network” in 2016

- 1 Teacher from each country to be nominated by Ministry
- Developing partnership plan among TVET Teacher Training Centres

## Proposed Activities

### 3) M&E by regularly on-line meeting every 3 months

- Regular monitoring and reporting
- Coordinating by VOCTECH, SEAMOLEC, Secretariat
- Develop progress reports of partnership

### 4) 2<sup>nd</sup> SEATVET KOSEN Consortium Meeting in Aug 2016

- Hosted by Indonesia (MOE, MOHE, Industry Sectors)
- 70 Policy Makers, TVET institutions

### 5) Other SEATVET KOSEN Consortium Meeting in other countries such as Thailand.....
