- Cancellation by selected students due to UNP compulsory internship program for 6 months (the same time with SEA TVET program)

RECRUITING BUDDY

- Open recruitment buddy
- Buddy was selected after number of receiving student announced (7 students)
- Number of buddy the same as number of receiving student (male for male and female for female)

MENTOR and SUPERVISOR

- Number of mentor was selected based on number of Field/subject of internship (2 Mentors for UNP)
- Supervisor depend on the internship place

TRAVELING PREPARATION

- UNP provided the airfare ticket and international health, and supported meal/daily allowance
- Several time meeting and discussion
- Attended the teleconference by SEM-MEO secretariat

PROBLEMS/CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS HANDLING SEA TVET STUDENTS

- Problem: Arriving time in Padang (20 to 22 January 2018)
Solution: University driver and Buddy of the arrived student stand by at the airport
- Problem: Food (Food in Padang is spicy)
Solution: choosing non-spicy food at restaurant or they cooked at buddy's home (no cooking at he UNP hotel)
- Problem: Language barrier at internship place
Solution: Buddy always accompany them at internship place
