- d. The sending institutions shall provide support in arranging for the air fare, meals/ daily allowance, health, accident, and travel insurance of the participating students.
- e. The receiving institutions will be responsible in arranging internship with international industrial partners and provides opportunities for students in classroom observation and other arrangement as stated in the SEAMEO Polytechnic Network guidelines.
- f. The receiving institutions will be responsible for accommodation and transportation service from and to the nearest airport.
- g. The receiving institutions must provide mentor (s) and buddy (ies) for participating students.
- h. The agreement will be implemented in reciprocal way.
- i. The eligibility of the students will be ensured by the sending and receiving institutions.
- j. The sending institutions shall conduct the pre-departure orientation for the participating students.
- k. The sending institutions shall ensure that the students are required to write the self-report using the Blog and submit the Company Supervisor Evaluation Form to SEAMEO at the end of internship.
- l. SEAMEO Secretariat will issue e-Certificate of Completion only for the students and mentors who completely submit their blog address and evaluation forms to the person in charge of SEAMEO Secretariat.
